With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 7: 23pm by Vice-President Jason Horn.

Public Session:

Matt Meckelberg presented information regarding his proposal for installing bat boxes around the lake as his Eagle Scout project. The board will give him the go-ahead to get us more details and move forward with the project.

Julia Held presented that designs for the next retrofit of storm drains have been presented for bids. They are of a circular design. The bids will go out to the town council next month. She also reported that a home on Sewell Road has installed a rather large bulkhead on what she thinks is parkland property. Jim Jones reported that he met with the contractor regarding this bulkhead and he approved it on condition of the installation of a fence and the replacement of any trees. Julia brought up the point that our easement dues pay taxes for some private lakefront property. She would like this discussed.

Jim Jones introduced Andrew Quirk as a new POA member and as a new prospect for a board member. Jane Pojedinec makes a motion to approve Andrew for a board member. Warren Colnaghi seconded the motion. Jason Horn made an official recommendation.

Membership Secretary's Report:

Karen Sarnowski reported that there are 1426 paid Easement member and 624 paid POA members at this time.

A resident of Avon Rd. tore down the house and put in an application for an in ground pool. She found that the block and lot for that property is gone, which determined that it was merged with the adjoining property. She is now on the dock waiting list. A letter had been sent to her, but was returned by the post office. She called Karen numerous times on her business phone asking for information about her dock assignment. The deed states that the brother, 2 sisters and the parents all own the one piece of property.

Karen sent an email to her explaining that there is one dock already with that property. She can apply for a second dock for the property, but will not be assigned one until all dock assignments for the location are met.

Treasurer's Report:

POA is ahead of projections and the committee budgets are in line for the last quarter of the year.

Easement – The collection of late fees and past dues has been above average.

Jason Horn mentioned that he believes we should allow the dues to be paid with credit cards. We can put an administration fee on the credit card usage, if necessary.

He believes we should go with a concrete bulkhead. Jim has an engineered plan for this concrete bulkhead. We will have to use the plan to apply for the permit. So, there will be no drawdown this year since we can't get the permit till next year.
